Health News - Halloween Safety Tips - Plan costumes that are bright and reflective or add reflective tape as needed. Make sure that shoes fit well and that costumes are short enough to prevent tripping. Consider non-toxic makeup and decorative hats as alternatives to masks, which can limit or block eyesight. Make sure that costumes and other accessories are flame-resistant. Avoid accessories such as sticks or swords as they may cause injury. Use flashlights to increase children's visibility. Travel in groups and with an adult. Insure that children eat some healthy food prior to trick-or-treating as that will help prevent them filling up on Halloween treats. Remind children that it is not safe to eat any candy until it has been checked by an adult. Set limits on the amount of candy that can be eaten each day.
