Enrollment Report: Enrollment as of today (9/9/09) is 207 students with one student unaccounted for. Enrollment at the close of school last year was 213 students. The primary reason for the difference is that we sent 26 students to Kennett, while registering 19 kindergarteners. We also do have a number of students who have moved in to and out of the district over the summer.
