Nurse Information - Protect Your Noggin!

Every year children are treated in hospital emergency departments for head trauma and injuries suffered from ski and snowboard accidents. Wearing a helmet can dramatically reduce the risk of head injury by up to 85%, and reduce the risk of brain injury by almost 90%. The Brett school is participating with the Child-N-Safety Program (CNS). This program offers ski/snowboard helmets at a discounted price of \$17.95. This is a wonderful price considering the average cost for a kid's helmet can be anywhere in the 50-100 dollar range. The CNS helmets have sizes and colors to match everyone's taste. Come pick up an order form in the main office today! Orders are due by **December 15th 2009**. Helmets will be available for pick up before winter break! Helmets are mandatory for all students taking part in the winter ski/snowboard program.

Health & Wellness Committee - The Brett School Lunch program is now serving milk that is artificial growth hormone (rBST) free. Our milk supplier, Hood, has contacted us to let us know that all fluid milk manufactured by Hood in New England is from farmers who pledge not to use artificial growth hormone. Although the FDA has stated that there are no quality or safety differences between milk from cows treated with artificial growth hormone and untreated cows, many parents have been concerned about milk manufactured with rBST and how it affects the health of their children and the health of the cows.

Guidance News - The fifth grade classes were surprised by a visit from the College Bear from NHHEAF. Students participated in a presentation entitled "Get on the Bus! Hitting the Open Road to College." Students were given the opportunity to explore their interests and careers that they might like to pursue. The eighth grade classes participated in "College Jeopardy" and had to brainstorm as teams how much they really know about college and the importance of working hard in high school to achieve and reach college goals.
