Nurse Information - H1N1 Second Dose Clinic

The Carroll County Coalition for public Health is hosting our second dose clinic of H1N1 vaccines. Children under the age of 10 need to receive a second dose. This is specifically a second dose clinic, but **all people** are welcome.

The clinic taking place at the Brett School is scheduled for **Thursday January 14, 2010 9:00am-11:00am**. If your child received their first dose at our clinic back in December and requires a second dose you will be notified by the school nurse and a consent form will be sent home.

If you wish to have your child vaccinated, even if they did not participate in the last clinic, feel free to pick up a consent form in the main office at the school. No child will be vaccinated without parent permission. Any further questions please contact Jen Forsythe, school nurse at 323-7271.
