### Nurse News - SUN SAFETY

With these hot summer-like sunny days we've been having, it's hard to stay inside. But we must remember that being outside in that hot sun posts some potential dangers. Skin cancer is the most common form of cancer in the U.S. It is estimated that one in five Americans will develop skin cancer in the course of their lifetime-and 90% of those cancers diagnosed are associated with sun exposure. So it is so important that you protect you and your family when you are outside in the sun. Here are some helpful sun safety tips: 1. UV Rays are strongest between 10am-4pm 2. SEEK SHADE when possible. Use umbrellas and brimmed hats. 3. Wear protective clothing when possible. 4. USE SUNSCREEN: generously apply sunscreen to all exposed skin. Use sunscreen that provides both UVA and UVB protection. Reapply every 2 hours-or after swimming or sweating. **DO NOT LET YOUR SKIN BURN!**
